27 Thank God for the Elders and deacons and all the work they do. Pray for God's wisdom, discernment and guidance the many decisions that need to be made.

28 Pray for those we know that have fallen away from the Lord. Help us to keep in contact, show love and support and gently guide them back to Him.

4 Pray for people especially young men and women who have been lured into joining dangerous cults or terrorist groups. Ask God to help those that now want to leave but face dangerous situations or fear for their lives if they do so.

5 Pray for Boris Johnson and the government during the BREXIT negotiations. .

6 Pray for new families to join the church. Pray that we would all be vigilant and look out for new faces and anyone who is sitting

alone. Help us to always smile, say hello and strike up conversation

7 Pray for the pregnant ladies in our church: Kezia, Becca and Kim. Pray for healthy and safe pregnancies.

8 Today (September) is Pastor Phil and Judith's last day at church before retirement. Thank God for the enormous blessing both have been over the years, for their love and commitment and for their hard work. Ask God to help them through this transition stage as they adjust .

14 Pray for all those that attend See and Know and for opportunities to share, that parents / carers would want to know more about the Lord and that the holy spirit would convict them .

15 Real Hope need more cooks and help with washing up. Pray that the right people would come forward to help. Thank God for Bruce and all the helpers who work so hard each week to reach the lost.

16 Lift Kirstie up to the Lord today. Pray that God would strengthen her daily and allow her to have enough good quality and refreshing rest.

17 Pray for the woman in El Salvador who have been imprisoned after suffering miscarriages. We pray for justice and deliverance for these woman and that they would get the right help and support in order to recover emotionally. Pray for those in authority that they would see the error of their ways.
